## APPLICATION ANNOUNCEMENT

**Next Aptitude Testing Date: FEBRUARY 2023**  
**DEADLINE: All applications must be mailed in or postmarked by Friday, December 23, 2022**

**Position:      Apprentice Electrician (Inside Wireman) starting wage: \$25.61/hour + benefits**

This is a five-year apprenticeship program. Apprentices work during the day and attend classes two nights per week. A journeyman certificate is awarded upon successful completion.

**Process:**

- 1) Applicants must meet minimum requirements.
- 2) Take the NJATC Aptitude Test (including Algebra and Function and a Reading Comprehension test) (see [www.njatc.org](http://www.njatc.org) or [www.electricprep.com](http://www.electricprep.com) website for more information). If you have taken the test at another IBEW-NECA location within six (6) months, please notify us when turning in your application and we will request your test score.
- 3) Qualify for interview if a qualifying score is achieved on the Aptitude Test or other entry method.

**Duties:**

The Apprentice Electrician works directly under the supervision of and assists a qualified Journeyman Electrician in installing or maintaining a variety of approved wiring methods for distribution of electrical light, heat, power, radio and signaling utilization systems in existing or new building under construction of residential, commercial, and industrial occupancies; including street and highway lighting, traffic signal and other outdoor above and below grade installations.

**Minimum Requirements:** Each applicant ***must***:

- 1) Be a minimum of eighteen (18) years of age at the time of application.
- 2) Provide a sealed official transcript for high school and/or post high school education and training. All GED records must be submitted if applicable.
- 3) Qualify for interview using the NJATC Electrical Trade's Aptitude Test developed and validated by the American Institutes for Research or other means.
- 4) Pass a drug-screen test and provide a copy of their DMV printout which verifies that they have a valid Driver's License *prior* to being indentured.

**What to Provide in Order to Complete Your Application and how to submit:**

- 1) Complete and print your application online at our website: [www.tricountyjatc.org](http://www.tricountyjatc.org) (***be sure to write your social security number on the application in the space provided***)
- 2) Valid Driver's License
- 3) High School Diploma, GED, or two-year Associate Degree or higher
- 4) Sealed, embossed, official transcript showing that you have completed one full year of High School Algebra with a "C" grade or better, or one post High School Algebra course with a passing grade of "C" or better. Successful completion of the online NJATC Tech Math class <http://www.njatc.utk.edu/index.htm> will also satisfy this requirement.
