APPLICATION ANNOUNCEMENT

Next Aptitude Testing Date: AUGUST 2024
DEADLINE: All applications must be mailed in before or postmarked by Friday, June 21, 2024

Position: Apprentice Electrician (Inside Wireman) starting wage: \$29.32/hour + benefits

This is a five-year apprenticeship program. Apprentices work during the day and attend classes two nights per week. A journeyman certificate is awarded upon successful completion.

Process:

- 1) Applicants must meet minimum requirements.
- 2) Take the NJATC Aptitude Test (two-part exam including Algebra and Functions and a Reading Comprehension ... see www.njatc.org or www.electricprep.com websites for more information). If you have taken the test at another IBEW-NECA location within the past two years, please notify us when turning in your application and we will request your test score.
- 3) Qualify for interview if a qualifying score is achieved on the Aptitude Test or other entry method.

Duties:

The Apprentice Electrician works directly under the supervision of and assists a qualified Journeyman Electrician in installing or maintaining a variety of approved wiring methods for distribution of electrical light, heat, power, radio and signaling utilization systems in existing or new building under construction of residential, commercial, and industrial occupancies; including street and highway lighting, traffic signal and other outdoor above and below grade installations.

Minimum Requirements for Apprenticeship: Each applicant *must*:

- 1) Be a minimum of eighteen (18) years of age at the time of application.
- 2) Provide a sealed official transcript for high school and/or post high school education and training. All GED records must be submitted if applicable.
- 3) Qualify for interview using the NJATC Electrical Trade's Aptitude Test developed and validated by the American Institutes for Research or other means.
- 4) Pass a drug-screen test and provide a copy of their DMV printout which verifies that they have a valid Driver's License *prior* to being indentured.

What to Provide in Order to Complete Your Application and how to submit:

- 1) Complete your application online at our website: www.tricountyjatc.org An auto-generated email will be sent to you with a PDF of the completed application. Print the PDF copy and mail it in with all other required documents (***be sure to write your social security number on the application in the space provided or include a copy of your social security card***).
- 2) Copy of your valid Driver's License (must be the copy of your actual driver's license with photo)
- 3) Copy of your High School Diploma, GED, or two-year Associate Degree or higher
- 4) Sealed, embossed, official transcript (unopened) showing that you have completed two semesters of High School Algebra 1 with a "C" grade or better, or one post High School Algebra course with a passing grade of "C" or better. Successful completion of the online NJATC Tech Math class www.skillsprep.org will also satisfy this requirement.
